Forbes America's Best Employers 2019 Methodology

To determine the list, Statista surveyed 50,000 Americans working for businesses with at least 1,000 employees. All surveys were anonymous, allowing participants to openly share their opinions. The respondents were asked to rate, on a scale of zero to 10, how likely they'd be to recommend their employer to others. Statista then asked respondents to nominate organizations in industries outside of their own. The final list ranks the 500 large and 500 midsize employers that received the most recommendations.
